# Fight for a Free Africa, While Conserving Your Domestic Rights

Fellow-Men of the Negro Race, Greeting:

I rejoice to find that you are continuing to give of your best for the support of the cause which is so dear to us all. Let nothing discourage you, but go forward, looking neither to right nor to left, until our progam for a free and redeemed Africa is realized.

The fact that the Africans have taken up the fight for their own liberation is an answer to the critics who have so often stated the impossibility of building a Negro nation in Africa.

Education will do more in changing the political aspect of the so-called "Dark Continent" than anything else in the twentieth century. Let us, therefore, give the natives the education that they need.

Africa's cry for freedom must be loud and long. During the period of 1914 to 1918 we heard the ringing cry of Woodrow Wilson for democracy and self-determination for weaker peoples. That cry has not yet died away, because Africa, sleeping though she has been for ages, has bestirred herself, and the echo of democracy has reached her, and we are determined that the sentiments stirred up in our hearts through this great appeal shall not die.

The Universal Negro Improvement Association makes its supreme appeal to the 400,000,-000 Negroes of the world for a better consideration of the African situation. All sensible men know that Africa, and Africa alone, will be the solution of the great Negro problem. Not until Africa gives out to the world a new civilization, not until Africa impresses the force and power of a black nationality, will men of color, the world over, get the respect that they

Fifteen million American Negroes and millions of West Indian and Central and South American Negroes are bound by the future of Africa. If Africa goes down in defeat before the great white man, who is now making his tremendous onslaught for domination through exploitation and native extermination, then we may as well sing our requiem and hand over posterity of our race to the curse of a new slavery. But with determination on our part to link hands and hearts together, moving and marching in one mighty phalanx, we can give to the world a new nation, an emancipated race that will live forever.

## Do Not Surrender Domestic Rights

But to fight for African redemption does not mean that we must give up our domestic fights for political justice and industrial rights. It does not mean that we must become disloyal to any government or to any country wherein we were born. Each and every race outside of its domestic national loyalty has a loyalty to itself; therefore, it is foolish for the Negro to talk about not being interested in his own racial, political, social and industrial destiny. We can be as loyal American citizens or British subjects as the Irishman or the Jew, and vet fight for the redemption of Africa, for the complete emancipation of the race.

Fighting for the establishment of Palestine does not make the American Jew disloyal; fighting for the independence of Ireland does not make the Irish-American a bad citizen. Why should fighting for the freedom of Africa make the Afro-American disloyal or a bad citizen?

The Universal Negro Improvement Association teaches loyalty to all governments outside of Africa; but when

it comes to Africa, we feel that the Negro has absolutely no obligation to anyone but himself.

Let us, therefore, on this western side give our help and encouragement to the natives to go ahead. Let them scatter the news of freedom, whether they do it by "drum wireless" or by any other means. We are in earnest. We intend to fight to a finish. Every Negro must support this program. And why not every liberal-minded white man? Negroes have helped white men to win their freedom, and they may as well help us to win ours, because we are going to get it, anyhow.

# WILL YOU FORGET GARVEY? NEVER! THEN CARRY ON!

"The hour has struck for universal activity among the Negro peoples of the world. It is for them now to concentrate on the building up of a great industry of their own. It is of no use for Negroes to continue to depend on the good graces of other races, because we are living in a world of selfish races—each striving for its own self."—Marcus Garvev.

We desire to remind you of the Rehabilitation Fund and its needed support by every one who holds membership in the Universal Negro Improvement Association.

There are many who will ask what is it all about. Some will say they do not see the need of raising so much money, while others will remain neutral and lukewarm. We feel it necessary to point out in detail just what this fund

will do and let you see that you ought to support it liberally. The following major items must be vigorously put into opera-

We are trying to add One Million new members to the U. N. I. A. In order to reach One Million people from headquarters, we will have to spend approximately ten cents for each person, which will mean Ten Thousand (\$10,000) dollars. Now every one is anxious to see the membership increased, and this amount of money must be spent to make the necessary step for the increase.

2. We desire to create a machine which will put in motion a general memorialization of every State Legislature, with a view of getting it to recognize the program of the U. N. I. A.

as the best means of solving the race problem. To do this effectively, we will have to spend in each State about Three Thousand (\$3.000) dollars for clerical work, and transportation of individuals connected with it. You can readily see, therefore, the need which faces us in this particular direction.

3. We have started to fight the unjust decision handed down by the court in Belize, involving the bequest of One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000) dollars, left by Mr. Morter for the U. N. I. A. for the furtherance of its African program. It is our opinion that this bequest will eventually come to the U. N. I. A. as intended by the late Sir Isiah Morter, in his last will and testament.

4. We are organizing and directing the political strength of the Negro for the racial good of all. In this, instead of acquiring money from the politician, the organization always finds it necessary to spend money to preserve the manhood rights

We have mentioned these things to draw your attention to the importance of them. There is no person within the U. N. I. A. who could not make a contribution toward this fund. If a greater and more powerful U. N. I. A. is to exist, it will come only through continued support of a zealous nature. Every one should contribute at least Twenty-five (\$25) dollars, even if it must be done on a weekly or monthly basis. Let us demonstrate the greatness of the U. N. I. A. doing the things which we now suggest.

We have passed the acid tests of all the great and dangerous critics, and have now evolved to the ponit where only our own inactiv ity, laziness or unwillingness to carry on will spell our failure. We are fully conscious of your divisional responsibilities, but

you must remember that the Divisions cannot become greater than the Parent Body. As the Federal Government is supreme in the body politic of the United States, so every member of the U. N. I. A. should regard the Parent Body as the supreme body, guiding and controlling the Divisions, and any failure to carry out Parent Body
