Washington, D.C.—"Banking is the life blood of business and business is the very heart of the country's activities," declared S. W. Rutherford. secretary-general manager of the National Benefit Life Insurance Company, addressing the National Negro Bankers' Association in its recent annual meeting here. Sturdy Negro Men and Women We want Sturdy Negro men and omen who are willing to assmilate themselves to help, from a patriotic viewpoint, in building up these countries for the Negro race. Men and women who will not be afraid to labor and work in every way for up-building of themselves and their new homes. The Universal Negro Improvement Association believes that such will be the salvation of the race because as we are, surrounded with the environments of an alien civilization, we are bound to go down and in

The Negro is Spoiled

The Negro is spoiled and has lost his consciousness in western civilization. He is without a purpose; he is without even the ordinary require-ments of self-respect. How can we hope to rise as we are?
