Let Harlem Be Health Conscious Is the Slogan Suggested by Health Commissioner Wynne-Dr. Lucien M. Brown Among Speakers

kins, Director of the New York Tuberculosis and Health Association, at the first all-day health conference ever to be held in Harlem, under the auspices of the Harlem Tuberculosis partment of Health and associated agencies, Tuesday, October 22nd.

This slogan was selected as highly appropriate following addresses by Tuberculosis and Health Association and Dr. Louis I. Dublin of the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company, in which belief was affirmed that, contrary to popular superstition, the Negro is not essentially racially susceptible to disease, but is, rather, a victim of a high sickness and mortality rate in New York because of the pe-culiar economic conditions to which

A fatalistic attitude with regard to the Negro and health is without foundation and destructive, according to Dr. Dublin. "The death rate of the Negro in New York City is a little less than that of most southern cities. Only in the rural section of the south are the Negro's health situations anything like what we should like to find.




