British Interested in Lessening Cost of Colonial Burden if Possible

LONDON, April 1.-The British Government intends to make one more attempt to create some form of a federation in its West Indian possessions, especially between Trinidad, the Windward Islands and the Leeand Islands.

Lord Passfield, Colonial Secretary, sent a disputch today to the West Indian Governors, proposing the appointment of a commission to conduct a comprehensive inquiry into the whole subject. After reviewing previous efforts at closer union in the West Indies, Lord Passfield wrote:

"The present crisis in the sugar inlustry has brought about an economic situation, particularly in the Leeward Islands and St. Lucia, which makes it important to explore every cossible avenue to increase economy and efficiency in administration, while improvements in sea communications and the rapid development of aerial navigation have materially diminished obstacles formerly existing and have emphasized the possibilities of cooperation in many activities of government."

Rykoff Takes Over Red Cabinet Post

MOSCOW—Alexei Rykoff, who as a Right Wing oppositionist to Joseph Stalin felt the metal of which Rush sia's man of steel is made, has climbed another rung toward reinstatement in power. The Central Executive Committee, which he once headed as presi dent, or premier, has appointed him Commissar of Post and Telegraph which is to say that once again he is included in the Soviet Cabinet.

The appointment follows his desig nation as a member of the Central Executive Committee by the Sixth All-Union Congress of Soviets re-cently, Previously he had been de-posed as president of the Central Committee-virtual Premier of the Soviet Union-because of his opposition to Stalin, head of the Communist Party. He later recanted and disavowed his Rightist views.
